Pistol Range

As you can see, we just need a little paint to complete the outside of our Semi Indoor Pistol Range.



We're just getting started on the inside. If you've been out to the range, you can see that we have installed some Styrofoam attic vents to catch the condensation that forms on the underside of our metal roof. That vent system also helps cool the attic by creating airflow just under the metal sheeting.



Right now, the cost of building materials is crazy, but it looks as though they're starting to come down. Because of the high prices our plans are only to get the ventilation, electrical, and the rest of the rough work done. That way we'll be ready do the build out when material costs abate. We have just repaired all the target frames and backers so they're ready for the summer. Please be aware of where your targets are placed; that alone will save us a couple hundred bucks that we could use for improvements.

Here's a skill improving drill for shooting
at a 5" circle:

Do this for the following yardage each time: One perfect shot, no time limit. If your shot is in the circle, move back. If not, repeat

3 yards, 7 yards, 10 yards, 15 yards

Do this exercise as fast as you can, but as slowly as you must. When you are hitting the bull every time, try a smaller bull.
