#### Rifle Range

The winter that wasn't continues... That has resulted in a lot of rifle range use, which is great! Unfortunately, I have been unable to keep the range in as good of condition as I like, but am doing my best. Everything is very wet and muddy, which is frustrating.

On a related matter, we are trying to get our air rifle range up and running. Mike and Linda have put this together and we should be good to go shortly. Just a few odds and ends left to sort out.

Remember, Spring will soon be sprung! See you at the range!

#### **Pistol Range**

The Pistol Range is finished except for painting the shooting lane counter and the floor. We will do that when the weather is warm enough. If you look closely, you can see the target carrier tracks on the rafters. All six lanes are operational. At this time, we have only opened the center two lanes, that should be enough for a while. The target frames are installed simply by "hooking" the frame onto the dowels attached to the carrier.



After you've finished shooting, please remove the target frames and store them inside the building. We are not sure if a strong wind would damage them if left hanging but why gamble when removing them is so easy. Also please close the lane doors.

Soon we will mark the ropes so the targets can be set at known distances of 7, 14, and 21 feet. Max distance is 25 feet. The target track and carrier apparatus are simple and sturdy, but if handled roughly, something could break. Should that happen, just move to another lane and leave a note so we can make repairs and/or improvements.

We plan to put up some shelves in the shooting booth, so you'll have a place to store your gun cases and a place to load your magazines. If you see something that needs improvement, make a note of it, and put it in the donation box along with your generous donation. We need to install a decent heater.


