#### **Pistol Range**

Look closely at the photos below. The first one shows moving the target truck out a short distance so you are able to see the wooden axel.



As you can see below the target frames are installed simply by "hooking" the frame onto the axel attached to the truck.



As we said last issue, the target track and carrier apparatus are simple and sturdy but if handled roughly something could break so, please use a modicum of caution. That means don't be rough.

After you've finished shooting, please remove the target frames by reversing the procedure and store them inside the building.

Soon we will be opening access to the full range so we will have to close the inside chamber for safety reasons. I'm sure you all understand.

Just a reminder, we are shooting pistols at the range on Saturdays at 2pm.


