#### **Pistol Range**

The weather is getting nicer, so we have shut down the inside pistol range to complete the building and painting. A plus is more shooters can use the range at the same time.

Our inside range door pass latch sometimes stuck giving the impression that we had shut down the range which wasn't the case. So, to eliminate the confusion we are going to install door closers without pass locks so that you only need to pull the door open to use the range. We will add deadbolt locks on the outside range door and the inside range door so we can isolate one range from the other.

There is a small group shooting Saturday afternoons starting at 2:00 pm. As far as I know they haven't started an organized competitive shoot but I'm thinking that's coming. As this grows, we could install a clock for timed events. If you have any ideas for range improvements or shooting events let us hear from you.
