Pistol Range

The weather is getting nicer, so we have shut down the inside pistol range to complete the building and painting.

That was how we started last month's newsletter. Well, the weather didn't stay nice (warm) enough to allow us to paint the floor and shooting counters so, we'll try to get it done this month.

There is some confusion about when the range is open partly because of a failed pass lock. Anyway, we plan to use the range as we have in the past; outdoors only in the spring, summer and fall seasons. The indoor range was constructed so we could shoot pistols when the winter weather shows up.

We are still experiencing some unnecessary damage to our permanent targets due to poor placement of our moveable target frames.

It's amazing how many times I find them placed there. My guess is that a few shooters want to shoot rifles on the pistol range and use the picnic table for bench rest shooting. We have installed door closers on the doors because the building stays cool when the doors are not left open, something we'll appreciate this summer.


